

Oceanic Teak Furniture

Chaise Lounger Assembly / Curve / Classic / Deluxe

There are just 5 parts – Lounger / 2 x Wheels & Brass Hardware / 2 x Leg sections (Front without Large holes & Back with Large holes to allow for the wheels to be inserted) Plus 8 x Brass Bolts

Tools required – Wooden or Rubber Mallet / Screwdriver

You will see there are coded stickers on the parts, make sure you align the relevant stickers to ensure the furniture is assembled correctly.

You may need to use a wooden or rubber mallet to tap the sections into place and ensure they are slotted together securely.

- 1) Place the Lounger top side down (use some of the packaging cardboard to protect the top while it is upside down). Be careful to secure the tray and backrest while doing this as they may open.
- 2) Insert the Front Leg Section (without the holes) making sure any stickers are correctly lined up and ensuring it is slotted fully and securely into place.
- 3) Insert the back/wheel section, making sure any stickers are correctly lined up and ensure it is slotted fully and securely into place.
- 4) Insert the brass bolts into the relevant holes on each side and hand tighten, then using the screwdriver fully tighten each bolt.
- 5) Insert the wheels as shown and hand tighten the securing nut.
- 6) Carefully rotate the Lounger and stand onto its legs – You may need help at this point. Be careful to secure the tray and backrest while doing this as they may open.
